Dear Utility District Leaders,

The Cypress Creek Flooding Task Force would like to present a plan for creating a Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District that would encompass the entire Cypress Creek Watershed. Its purpose would be to provide the funds for design and construction of the facilities identified in the Cypress Creek Implementation Plan released by the HCPCD earlier this year. That plan includes the construction of 22 stormwater detention ponds--from Hardy Toll Road to 290. This plan will help mitigate flooding--and also investigate the creation of parks, utility district drainage partnerships, and other mitigation solutions within the Watershed.

We believe the creation of a Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District is needed; and we want you PUD and MUD leaders, whose utility districts are directly impacted by Cypress Creek flooding, to be informed regarding those plans and participate in the process.

Please join us at an informational meeting on September 6th, from 6:30-7:30 pm, at the Cypress Creek Christian Community Center (6823 Cypresswood Drive, Spring).
